

Terms and Conditions – RACQ International Women’s Day Fun Run

Race Bib Prize Promotion

1. Entry into the RACQ International Womens' Day Fun Run 2020 (IWDFR) **Race Bib Prize Promotion** ("**Promotion**") is deemed to be an acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. Information on how to enter the Promotion and prizes associated with the Promotion form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. Entries for the Promotion commence on 00:01hrs AEST Sunday 08 March 2020 and close at 10:15hrs AEST Sunday 08 March 2020 ("**Promotion Period**").
3. Entry is open to IWDFR participants ("**Entrants**").
4. Directors, officers, management, employees and other staff (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees and other staff) of Mater Foundation and their related bodies corporate and agents are ineligible to enter.
5. Directors, officers, management, employees and other staff (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees and other staff) of The Royal Automobile Club of Queensland Limited (RACQ) and their related bodies corporate and agents are ineligible to enter.
6. The Promoter reserves the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter have reason to believe breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or otherwise improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
7. To enter, Entrants must do the following during the Promotion Period;
 - o Remove the RACQ tear off section from their race bib; and
 - o Place the tear off section in the marked RACQ barrel located at the RACQ stand in the Finishers Village
8. Each valid entry received during the Promotion Period will be placed in the Major Prize Draw.
9. There is a total of one major prize winner ("**Major Prize Winner**")
10. The total prize pool is valued at \$1,000
11. The Major Prize Winner will receive:
 - 11.1. A \$1,000.00 RACQ Bank eftpos card, which expires 12 months after the winner has activated the card. Instructions on how to activate the card will be provided to the Major Prize Winner when they receive the prize.
12. The Major Prize draw will take place at 10:30am AEST on Sunday 8 March 2020 on stage at the Finishers Village, City Botanic Gardens, Alice Street Brisbane. The first valid entry drawn will be the winner.
13. The Major Prize Winner will be advised in person, if present, or by phone if not present at time of draw. They will also receive notification by email within 72 hours of the draw.
14. The winning Race Bib number will be published on www.womensdayfunrun.com.au within 7 days of the draw.
15. The Major Prize Winner will receive their prize at the event, if present at time of draw. If not present at time of draw, the prize will be sent by registered mail to an address nominated by the winner, within 14 days of the draw.
16. Entries must be received by the Promoters within the Promotion Period. Entries are deemed to be received upon the bib tear off being placed in the barrel. Records of the Promoters are final.
17. Prizes
 - 17.1. The value of the prize pool is accurate at the date of commencement of the Promotion Period. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize after that date.
 - 17.2. The Prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
 - 17.3. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into, including in the event of a dispute.

- 17.4. If a purchase exceeds the face value of the voucher, you must make up the difference with another payment method; you are liable for all transactions on your voucher.
- 17.5. If for any reason the prize is not used by the expiry date identified on the voucher, the prize, or any remaining portion of the prize will be forfeited.
- 17.6. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen vouchers.
- 17.7. If the Major Prize Winner is under the age of 18 years (where entry by persons under 18 is permitted), the Promoter will award the prize to the Major Prize Winner's parent or guardian.

- 19.1. If any act or omission, event or circumstance occurs which is beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter and which prevents the Promoter from complying with these Conditions of Entry, the Promoter will not be liable for any failure to perform or any delay in performing its obligations.
- 19.2. The Promoter reserves the right, subject to any applicable law, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion.
- 19.3. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered, including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss, or for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving, taking or using any Prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 19.4. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liability incurred as a result of participating in this Promotion. Any tax liability arising as a result of accepting any Prize is the responsibility of the Winner.
